

6 SNOW BELLES Flip-It Border Instructions

Want to combine your blizzardy babes into one big snowy stitchery? Here's how to do it! We stitched the entire series together on 32 ct. Amber Linen (Wichelt Imports). Choose whatever fabric color and count you prefer. Just be sure to select a fabric dark enough for the snow to show – these ladies love to wear white, no matter what the season!

Stitch count for the entire project is 144W x 176H.

The thread list for the project is below. We used one skein of all colors, except for 5 skeins of whitewash.

Weeks Dye Works begonia, chestnut, crimson, deep sea, grasshopper, monkey grass, palomino, tiger's eye, whitewash (5)

Crescent Colours blackbird, Colonial copper, queen bee, really teal

Gentle Art Sampler Threads huckleberry

Use our placement graph for placing the 6 designs in the group project. We have duplicated the borders on each design, to aid in easy placement. Just match the borders on the individual charts with the borders provided in our graph, and you're ready to stitch the freezin' fems! The FREE design elements are shown on the big graph. These elements will tie all the designs together.
