## Flip-It Border Instructions

Ready to combine all 4 Seasons into one, glorious year-round masterpiece? Here's how to do it!
We stitched the entire series together on 28 ct . Amber linen (WIchelt \#7615). Choose whatever fabric color and count you prefer. Just be sure to select a fabric dark enough for the white stitching to show up well.

Stitch count for the entire project is $275 \mathrm{~W} \times 99 \mathrm{H}$.
Thread list for the entire project is below. We used one skein of all colors, except for 2 skeins of grits.
Weeks Dye Works bayberry, begonia, bluebonnet, blue heron, carrot, cayenne, cocoa, collards, dried sage, grits (2), gold, grass-hopper, guacamole, gunmetal, lilac, Oscar, palomino, plum, sweetheart rose, Tiger's eye. DMC 3822

Use our placement graph for placing the 4 designs in the group project. Just find the outer edges of each seasonal design, and place in the appropriate box.

We wish you many happy stitches, all year long!
